If you haven't already registered on mycanadalifeatwork.com, we encourage you to set up your account and download your digital ID card. Here are a few tips to get the most out of your plan with My Canada Life at Work.

1. Register for online services: You'll need your plan number and Team Member ID to complete your registration. The new plan number is 180654. Your digital benefit card online on My Canada Life at Work or on the My Canada Life at Work mobile app under Cards.



- **2.** Go to <u>mycanadalifeatwork.com</u> and log in.
- **3.** Register to submit your claims online and review your coverage and balance details.

You can go to your favourite app store and download the app. Search for **GroupNet Mobile**. Either way, you can submit your claims, see what your plan covers and even download your digital benefits card to your Apple Wallet or Google Pay. Here are a few other ways you can use My Canada Life at Work.

You can get your claim payments deposited into your bank account. Just add your banking details when you register. You can also find out when your claim has gone through by going to your profile and selecting Notifications then Claim payment notifications. When you set your notifications settings, you can choose email or text.

Consult+ Free Virtual Health Care Available to All Team Members and Family Members

With Consult+ through our Canada Life workplace benefits, you have 24/7 access to non-urgent medical care, with service in both English and French. All full-time Team members and their families have access to Consult+ as part of your group benefits plan through Canada Life at no cost to you.

Consult+ is health care you can access through an app or website. It lets you communicate with doctors, nurses or other health care professionals for non-urgent medical care. You can use it anywhere you're comfortable talking via phone call, video or chat.

Simply open the Consult+ app or log on to the <u>mycanadalifeatwork.</u> <u>com</u> website. If you don't have an online account for your benefits plan,

you'll need to register first before you can access Consult+. Click the "Register" button to create your account. Consult+ is health care you can access 24/7.

Use Consult+ to:

- Talk to a qualified healthcare professional about a wide range of concerns — anything from allergies to pink eye to UTIs
- Access self-led therapy for mild and moderate depression and anxiety.
- Get referrals for lab work or to see a specialist if necessary.
- Ask general questions about your well-being.



- * Certain prescriptions or refills can be sent to your pharmacy electronically.
- Find other health services like dieticians, psychologists or life coaches.

Flu Season Is Here

Most people who are six months of age and older should get a flu shot during every flu season.

- # Get a flu shot every year.

- * Cover your nose and mouth when you cough or sneeze.
- Clean and disinfect surfaces and objects that may be contaminated.



Did you know?

- * 2 weeks Time it takes after vaccination for an adult to develop diseasefighting antibodies against the flu.
- ★ 1 to 4 days Typical time it takes for symptoms to show up once you've caught the virus. Adults can be contagious from the day before symptoms begin through 5 to 10 days after the illness starts.
